

Common Integrated Police Application (CIPA)





The Police functioning in most of the cases are largely manual. Police stations keep manual records of events, crimes, investigation etc. The registration and investigation and other Police tasks most certainly require some degree of automation that would not only improve the work quality of police but also the efficiency.

The main task of computerizing the Police functioning is to maintain the details pertaining to all the activities of the Police Stations relating to Crime & Criminal. The System will provide required information to the higher levels periodically and when required. The system will also generate various statutory reports for the smooth functioning of the Police Station.

CIPA (Common Integrated Police Application) focuses on the functional and the day-to-day work requirements of various Police Stations which includes the Registration of various cases in form of FIR's including Unclaimed Properties, Missing persons reported at the Police Stations, their investigation by recording the information about the progresses form time-to-time in the case including coordination of lost and the recovered properties, Disposal/Charge Sheet by Police, prosecution which results in disposal of Case by the Court etc. **CIPA** also focuses on the current practices,

procedures and problems at the Police Stations and translates them into broad system specifications and software requirements.

At present two Police Station i.e., Khajanchi Hat (K. Hat) & Purnea Sadar are equipped **CIPA** project, Six Police Station of Purnea District i.e., Baisee, Kasba, Banmankhi, Barhara, Bhawanipur & Dhamdaha **CIPA** project are soon going to be started.
