विषय : पंचांग वर्ष, 2016 (31.12.2016 को समाप्त हुआ वर्ष) की अचल सम्पति विवरणी दो प्रतियों में दिनांक 31.01.2017 तक समर्पित किये जाने के संबंध में।

महाशय,

निदेशानुसार उपर्युक्त विषय के संबंध में कहना है कि अखिल भारतीय सेवायें (आचार) नियमावली, 1968 के नियम 16(2) में अचल सम्पति का ससमय समर्पण एक अनिवार्य सरकारी दायित्व के रूप में उपबंधित है।

ज्ञात हो कि भारत सरकार द्वारा अब उक्त दायित्व को नियत समय पर पूरा करने की अनिवार्यता निगरानी स्वच्छता दिये जाने हेतु एक आवश्यक शर्त के तौर पर भी स्थापित कर दिया गया है (छाया प्रति संलग्न)। साथ ही, अचल सम्पति विवरणियों को सार्वजनिक किया जाना भी अपरिहार्य कर दिया गया है।

अचल सम्पति विवरणी समर्पण का विहित प्रपत्र कार्मिक एवं प्रशिक्षण विभाग, भारत सरकार के अधिकारिक वेबसाईट पर उपलब्ध है। सुलभ प्रसंगवश छाया प्रति संलग्न है।

अतः अनुरोध है कि दिनांक 31.12.2016 की स्थिति पर आधारित पंचांग वर्ष 2016 की वार्षिक अचल सम्पति विवरणी विहित प्रपत्र में (जिसमें नाम, बैच वर्ष एवं समर्पण की तिथि अनिवार्य रूप से अंकित हो) दो प्रतियों में दिनांक 31.01.2017 तक निश्चित रूप से विभाग को उपलब्ध कराना सुनिश्चित की जाय, ताकि गृह मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार, नई दिल्ली के अधिकारिक वेबसाईट पर प्रकाशित करते हुए उसकी मूल प्रति दिनांक-28.02.2017 तक गृह मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार को उपलब्ध कराया जा सके।



Subject: Filing of Annual Immovable Property Return by the IPS officer - Reg.

I am directed to refer to the subject and to say that the in pursuance to the Govt. of India decision under Rule 16 of the All India Services (Conduct) Rules, 1968, Annual Immovable Property Return (AIPR) for the year 2015 (as on 01.01.2016) is required to be submitted by the IPS Officer on or before 31st January, 2016.

2. Past experience shows that numbers of IPS officers are not complying with the existing instructions regarding filing of AIPR and making unnecessary correspondence to this Ministry. In the absence of correct AIPR status, being Cadre Controlling Authority, it is not possible for this Ministry to provide vigilance/cadre clearance to the IPS officers for various purposes as the same has been linked with filing of IPRs.

3. In order to avoid unnecessary correspondence and minimize the delay in conveying Vigilance clearance, Cadre clearance of IPS officers for various purposes to the concerned Ministry/Organization/State Govt., all the State Governments are requested to issue a clear cut direction to the concerned IPS officers under your jurisdiction to submit their IPR for the year 2015 within the stipulated period i.e. by 31.1.2016. On receipt of the IPRs the same may be uploaded by the State Govts. on the MHA web site by 29.02.2016. Vigilance clearance will be denied in respect of officers who have not submitted their IPR for the year 2015 within the prescribed time limit i.e. during the period from 01.01.2016 to 31.01.2016.

4. Before uploading the IPRs on the website of MHA, it may be ensured by the State Government that IPS officers must have put date under their signature in IPR-2015. If an IPS officer has submitted his IPR-2015 without putting date under the signature in IPR-2015, the concerned State Govt. while forwarding their hard copy of IPR may confirm the date of submission with authenticated records and relevant papers to this Ministry. Otherwise their vigilance clearance will be denied for the whole year. All the concerned IPS officers may be advised accordingly.

5. All State Governments and concerned organizations are requested to forward the hard copies of IPRs of the IPS officers who have submitted the IPRs-2015 within the stipulated period (i.e. by 31.1.2016) to this Ministry by 29.02.2016 positively otherwise it will be presumed that the remaining IPS officers have not submitted their IPRs-2015 within the specified date.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Guidelines regarding grant of 'Vigilance Clearance' to AIS Officers.

The undersigned is directed to say that it has been decided by the Government that officers who have not submitted the annual property returns in time would be denied vigilance clearance and will not be considered for empanelment for senior level posts in Government of India. Accordingly, this Department's OM No. 104/33/2005-AVD I, dated 29/10/2007, laying down guidelines regarding grant of vigilance clearance to AIS officers, is hereby amended as under:

In para 2 of DOP&T OM No. 104/33/2005-AVD.I, dated 29/10/2007, a new sub-para (f) will be inserted as under:

- (f) Vigilance clearance shall be denied to an officer if he fails to submit his annual immovable property return of the previous year latest by 31st January of the following year, as required under Government of India decisions under Rule 16 of the All India Services (Conduct) Rule, 1968
